The UW Psychiatry Consultation Line helps eligible providers in Washington state who want clinical advice regarding adult patients (18+) with mental health and/or substance use disorders.

How does it work?

- › Call 877-WA-PSYCH (877-927-7924)
- › Complete a brief intake
- › Consult with a UW psychiatrist
- › Receive written documentation of recommendations

Why would I call?

You have questions about

- › Assessment and diagnosis
- › Treatment planning, including medication management or other treatments

Who can call?

Prescribing health care providers in Washington state from

- › Primary care clinics
- › Community hospitals and emergency departments
- › County and municipal correctional facilities
